# **Apple Crunch Pupcakes Recipe**

### **Ingredients**

- 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup water
- ½ cup applesauce (unsweetened)
- 2 Tbsp honey
- 1/8 Tbsp vanilla extract
- 1 medium egg
- 4 cups whole wheat flour
- 1 cup dried apple chips (unsweetened)
- 1 Tbsp baking powder

### **Directions**

- Preheat oven to 350°F
- Mix water, applesauce, honey, egg, and vanilla together in a bowl
- Add remaining ingredients and mix until well blended
- Pour into lightly greased muffin pans
- Bake 1 ¼ hours
