Traditional Chinese Food Therapy

Introduction

中國傳統的食療介紹

Chinese food therapy is the understanding how food effects the body's organs. This practice can be traced all the way back to 650s during the Tang dynasty. In the Chinese food therapy, food is characterized as warming (Yang based) and cooling (Yin based) and neutral. Warming foods are typically high-calorie, needs high heat for cooking, spicy or bitter, or "hot" in color (red, orange, etc). These foods should be avoided during the summer. Cooling foods are low-calorie, watery, soothing or sour in taste, or "cool" in color (whitish, green, etc). It is recommended to eat as much of these foods during "hot" conditions.
