This year's field seminars have spurred some nice accomplishments and heightened the interest in field. This workshop is our way of educating and extending additional training information to those who want to take their dogs beyond the WC/WCX to Junior, Senior and/or Master Hunter titles or just to have some more fun in the field with your dog.

Mitch White is a professional field dog trainer and is well known for his ability to work individually with soft dogs. He is an accomplished trainer who holds the accolades of many field titles and Master National awards. His website is: <u>Gamekeepers Retrievers, Ltd.</u>

The workshop will accommodate fourteen working spots and unlimited auditing spots.
