This years field seminars have spurred some nice accomplishments and heightened the interest in field. This workshop is our way of educating and extending additional training information to those who want to take their dogs



beyond the WC/WCX to Junior, Senior and/or Master Hunter titles or just to have some more fun in the field with your dog.

Peanut Butter Banana Pupcakes Recipe

Ingredients:

- ♦ 1 cup all-purpose flour
- ♦ 1 cup whole wheat flour
- ♦ 1 Tbsp baking powder
- ♦ 1/2 tsp salt
- ♦ 1/2 cup peanut butter
- ♦ 1 large egg
- ♦ 3/4 cup milk
- ♦ 1 banana
- ♦ 3 Tbsp oil
- ♦ 1/4 cup honey

Directions:

- Preheat oven to 400 degrees and either line a muffin time with paper cups or lightly spray with
- Mix together all of the dry ingredients and set the bowl aside
- Mix together peanut butter, egg, milk, banana, honey and oil until smooth and well blended
- ◆ Using a large spoon or rubber spatula, fold the wet ingredients into the dry. Note: the resulting mixture will be somewhere between a batter and a really sticky dough.
- Spoon the mixture into the muffin pan, filling each cup to about 3/4 of the way full
- Bake for 12-14 minutes if making mini muffins and 18-20 minutes for regular-sized

Store in an airtight container at room temperature and they'll keep for about a week.
