Treat Recipe

Ingredients:

- 2 1/4 cups whole wheat flour
- 1/2 cup unsweetened applesauce
- 1/2 cup cornmeal
- 2 tsp vanilla extract
- 1/2 cup rolled oats
- 2 eggs, beaten
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 3 tbsp. low-sodium peanut butter
- 1/2 cup water

Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 400°F
2. Lightly grease 2 large baking sheets
3. Mix whole wheat flour, cornmeal, rolled oats, and baking powder together in a bowl
4. Light mix water, applesauce, and vanilla extract into the flour mixture
5. Stir in eggs and peanut butter
6. Turn the dough onto a floured surface and knead until no longer sticky, about 1 minute
7. Roll out the dough to 1/4” thickness; use cookie cutter and arrange onto baking sheets
8. Bake for 15 minutes
9. Turn oven off and allow treats to sit in the oven as it cools for another 30 minutes
10. Remove treats from oven allow to cool for another 10 minutes before removing to a wire rack to cool completely.
