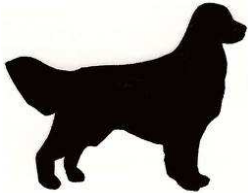

From the North:

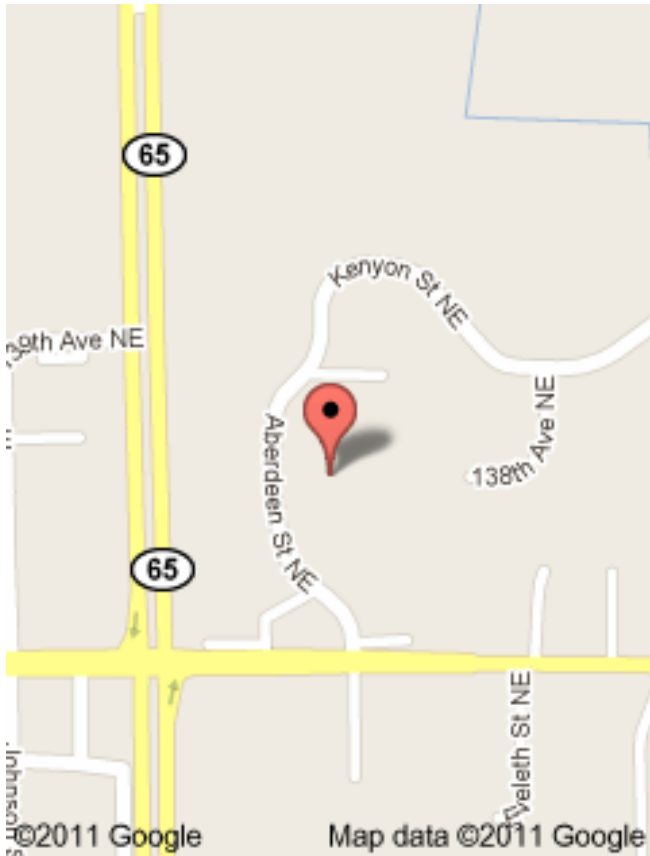
Take Highway 65 south to Bunker Lake Blvd (CR 116)
 Turn left onto Bunker Lake Blvd
 Turn left on Aberdeen
 The show site is on the right

From the East:

Take Bunker Lake Blvd (CR 116) west to Aberdeen St
 Turn right on Aberdeen
 The show site is on the right

From the West:

Take Bunker Lake Blvd east.
 Cross Highway 65
 Aberdeen is the first left after crossing Highway 65
 Turn left on Aberdeen

FOOD: Food is available for workers only at the trials on the showsite. There are restaurants and fast food vendors within a short driving distance from the show site.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles will conform to current requirements of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

CRATING SPACE: Limited with no ex-pens being allowed. Please stack crates when possible.

SHOES: Please, to help preserve the matting, wear clean athletic shoes. No spike shoes and/or sticky spray on the dogs' paws. The mats have a lot of "grip", so turf shoes are not recommended.

WARM-UPS: A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

PRIZE AND AWARDS: Flat ribbons will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each Standard, Jumpers With Weaves, FAST and Premier. A green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score. "New Title" Rosettes and "Double Q" Rosettes will be available for qualifying teams. A MACH/PACH bar and Rosette will be awarded to each team earning a MACH/PACH. The club reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. All awards and prizes must be claimed at the show as none will be mailed.

1st Prize: Blue 2nd Place: Red 3rd Place: Yellow 4th Place: White Qualifying Ribbon: Dark Green

REFUNDS: Entry fees for females that come into season and injured dogs after the closing date will be refunded (minus a \$ 15.00 administrative fee per day) if a veterinarian certificate is presented to the trial secretary prior to the start of judging. A full refund is to be reimbursed to any entrant whose entry is replaced by a Wait-Listed entry. Refunds will not be given for refund amounts of \$ 5 or less. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by vet or judge, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee.

MOVE-UP REGULATIONS: If a dog earns an agility title before this event it can be advanced to the next level of competition. However, written notice must be given to the Trial Secretary, no later than 6:00 PM on Monday, January 15 or at the close of the trial Friday and Saturday which will be considered the awarding of ribbons for the last class of that day. Move-ups will be added to the end of the running order of the class they move up to. Every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class. No verbal changes can be accepted.

RINGSIDE: **Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused. **Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

SAFETY/BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY: **The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Greater Twin Cities Golden Retriever Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Greater Twin Cities Golden Retriever Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Greater Twin Cities Golden Retriever Club or any official thereof. **All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.
