SPACES: 15 spaces available for owner/dog teams (we want you to have the most hands on experience possible). Will accept 10 extra audits. We are accepting reservations for GTCGRC members for the next 2 weeks, then we will allow other clubs and the public to join.

ATTENDEES: Dogs 6 months old or older to participate in the workshop. ***If you have a pup younger than 6 months, it's a good idea to audit the class, and then ask Mike questions geared toward puppies during the cocktail hour.
