COVID-19 ADVISORY AND RELEASE FORM

Applicants must sign and return this release form for their entries to be accepted.

This trial may be canceled at any time due to unforeseen new or renewed COVID-19 restrictions.

COVID-19 guidelines (subject to change):

- PLEASE STAY HOME if you have tested positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of the event or are showing any signs of the COVID-19 illness. See "Refunds for COVID-19 illness".

- 5. Wear a mask when among others, even if you have been vaccinated. Have it ready to put on in a moment's notice.
- 6. Practice proper handwashing.
- 7. Park vehicles reasonably spaced apart.
- 8. Avoid using phones, cameras, pens, pencils, and touching dogs other than your own. Hang on to your own dog's leash during off-leash searches. Volunteer videographers will not be available.
- 9. Bring your own food and drink.
- 10. Since crating will be out of your vehicle, bring what you need to keep yourself and your dog comfortable.
- 11. Read and understand the latest information provided by the State of Minnesota: <u>https://mn.gov/covid19/</u>



Additional notes:

- 12. Do not carpool with another person unless that person is an immediate family member that has been free of illness for at least 14 days.
- 13. Spectators will be allowed at judge's discretion.
- 14. A limited supply of masks and gloves will be on hand for those who forget them. Hand sanitizer spray bottles will be located at various stations.
- 15. If the GTCGRC Board and Event Committee needs to cancel this event due to changing COVID-19 restrictions before the trial begins at 7am on May 14, 2021, your check will be shredded. There will be no refunds for cancelation once the trial begins.

Refunds for COVID-19 illness:

- 16. If requested, your unused entry fees will be refunded if you are diagnosed with COVID-19 between the ENTRY CLOSING DATE (May 5, 2021 at 5pm) and any of the run dates in the trial (May 14, 15 or 16). You must provide a statement from your doctor.
